In 1983, AutoCAD Crack was released as a microcomputer application, with user and workstation interfaces intended to be driven by the internal display controller in the Apple II/II+/IIfx computers. Subsequently, the Apple II/IIfx peripheral cards supporting the 12-bit RGB color display were replaced by one 256-color bitmap display card, enabling AutoCAD to support color displays, a feature that was later incorporated into other programs by the same authors and programmers. This work, and the dual mode of the early releases, led to numerous revisions and re-releases of AutoCAD, including many features that would be incorporated into other CAD software. The underlying programming and graphics concepts in AutoCAD were developed by George Mason University's School of Architecture, where AutoCAD was created in a joint effort between and under the leadership of mechanical engineers Steve Bressler and Dave Turek, and architect Dr. Fred Moore, who served as the software architect and artist. AutoCAD's initial release was initially a separate, stand-alone piece of software, but was later incorporated into the "AutoCAD Deluxe" package, which also contained additional drawing applications. This package was sold by Microbyte Corporation from 1983 to 1987.

Design history Early AutoCAD versions were developed on the Apple II computers, which had just become available. In the summer of 1982, Apple Computer released the Apple II, a mass-market color computer based on the Motorola 6502 CPU (a 16-bit, non-MOS compatible variant of the 6800 CPU series), and a custom-designed display controller that could emulate EGA, VGA, or SVGA-compatible display modes and resolutions. The Apple II was also equipped with a number of new high-end peripherals, including the Motorola 6845 memory-mapped parallel port and a built-in DAC. The Apple II graphics hardware was capable of displaying resolutions up to 640x400 in text mode, and a full-screen resolution of about 300x200 at video refresh rates of anywhere from 33 to 60 Hz. Originally it was not possible to drive the Apple II display controller from software running on the Apple II itself, but by using the aforementioned parallel port and a third-party Apple IIfx expansion card, it became possible to use the Apple II and Apple IIfx to display graphics. By August 1982, a small prototype version of AutoCAD was in the works, and the developers chose to work with
