A: The vendor (AutoCAD) uses this special file for license distribution. It is signed with their private certificate (fingerprint: 20 56 55 cb 01 33 8a c4 2a 4b cf 35 38 a3 ac 07 4a 40 d7 ff 10 ed d1 ed 02 5b db 58 40 95). Some scanners or the antivirus you're using may view this file as malware and warn you. It's not harmful. This private key should never be shared to the public. Only Autodesk can release a new version of that file (actually when you're opening the new version, it's not signing the file, but changing the checksum). This means, that the public key is located in Autodesk's infrastructure and the only way to get the public key is to work for Autodesk. There is no way for a normal user to get that key, so trying to steal it with XForce is pointless. I think it's clear that it's not a XForce issue, but simply a malfunction in the antivirus.
